In the city and from city to villages the main means of transportation is small route vans. In the remote areas you can ride in a pickup taxi to some villages. However, for our pastors and missionaries their main mode of transportation is, for the fortunate ones a motorcycle, and for others "Push bikes." However, some of the pastors do not have bicycles and walk to and from the churches. Pastors Matola, Chisambi, and Chagwambale walk 20 miles to hold services then walk 20 miles back home. This month we were able to send the money to buy 18 new bicycles. The photo to the right is of Pastors Chifundo Max, Moyo Mabuka, and Frank Anadu with their new "Push Bikes."



While Covid-19 shutdowns, prices for seed, food, and living expenses increasing dramatically the churches are also dealing with drought and crop failures as seen in the first photo below. But again God has provided and we were able to send money to buy food that will be distributed to the church members to help them in this time of need and at the same time have an open door to preach the Gospel.



Another blessing is seeing some of the students complete their seminary training and graduate. It is wonderful to see this brother's wife standing with her husband to support him in his ministry. Upon graduation the church where they will pastor request their ordination. Then they go forth to start new churches like the Nkhanzi church seen in the last picture. This new church is still meeting under a tree until they can build a building.
