We have reached the time of the year when the farmers burn off the stubble of their rice fields to prepare for replanting their rice. The whole county side and the city is engulfed in smoke. The wealthy leave until its over and others just suffer it. We have a smoke de-humidifier in the church and one for each room in our home. But they don't seem to help much. It is a menace to our health. The burning usually lasts from Feb. until May when the rain comes.

At Trinity Baptist we have received a young man to be with us from the u.k. Our financial support remains firm for which we thank the Lord and you who are our faithful supporters in this mission work.

We ask you to pray for the street in front of our church as it has badly deteriorated. We went this week to the city hall and reminded them that they have a responsibility to keep the streets repaired. This is a real need for prayer that they will do this.

**Another prayer request is:** for Mrs. Green's health (who manages the Children's Home) as we have not seen much improvement with the medical problem called "Tinitus" This causes her at times to loose her balance. My health remains fairly good tho I have a long standing heart condition. I am not feeble and do work and preach every week.

The Lord is still blessing our work in the church and Children's Home. We just learned that the Lord is sending us more children to be cared for in our children's Home. They are so poor and no place to stay for their education to continue. The villages they are from is so far from their town that they are unable to go to school.
